The source of collection of your personal information:

We collect personal information directly from the following data subjects:

- Prospective clients who enquire about our financial services.
- Clients who have appointed Galileo Capital Group financial representative as their broker or intermediary.
- Policyholders who enter into a policy with an Insurer via Galileo Capital Group.
- Investors who invest into an investment product with a Investments house or asset manager via Galileo Capital Group.
- Prospective clients booking appointments with a Galileo Capital Group financial planner for an hourly consultation.
- We may also collect information about our clients from other sources such as Astute, and NCino KYC Africa with your authorization. Astute to help us identify and verify your investments and policy information to conduct a financial needs analysis on you and NCino KYC Africa to assist us with our FICA compliance obligations.

Law authorising or requiring collecting your personal information:

As an authorised financial services provider, we are obligated in terms of the following legislation to collect your personal information insofar as it relates to the rendering of the relevant financial services to you:

- Financial Advisory and Intermediaries Services Act 37 of 2002;
- Financial Intelligence Centre Act 38 of 2001;
- Insurance Act 18 of 2017;
- Short-Term Insurance Act 53 of 1998;
- Long-Term Insurance Act 52 of 1998;

Purpose for Processing your personal Information:

We collect, hold, use and disclose your personal information mainly to provide you with access to the services and products that we provide. We will only process your information for a purpose you would reasonably expect, including:

- Complying with the obligations contained in the contract concluded between yourself and Galileo Capital Group.
- Providing you with advice, products and services that suit your needs and as requested by you.
- To verify your identity as required by the Financial Intelligence Centre Act 38 of 2001.
- To issue, administer and manage your investments and other financial planning needs.
- To process claims and to assist you to change investments from one product provider to another.
- Notifying you of new products or services that may be of interest to you.
- To confirm, verify and update your details.
- To comply with any other legal and regulatory requirements.

Some of the aforementioned personal information may be mandatory to provide within the context of product providers' requirements and disclosures.

Failing to provide compulsory information may lead to Galileo Capital Group's inability to carry out the functions necessary to perform as an authorized financial services provider.

Third Parties and your personal information

We may need to share your information with third parties that provide advice, reports, analyses, products, or services that you have requested. Where we share your information, we will take all precautions to ensure that the third party will treat your information with the same level of protection as required by us.

These third parties may include:

- Your employer. (where applicable)
- Third Party service providers that assist with collation and consolidation of data from product providers.
- Third Party CRM Providers that provide us with customer relationship platforms and systems.
- Third Party software financial planning tool providers that assist us with doing a financial needs analysis for you.

- Analytics and search engine providers assisting in the enhancement of our website.
- Information Technology specialists assisting us with data storage, security, processing, analytics, reporting etc.
- Auditors of Galileo Capital Group for financial auditing purposes.
- Regulatory or governmental authorities such as the Financial Sector Conduct Authority and the Prudential Authority.

Complaints and objections

As a data subject, you have the right to –

- Request that we confirm, free of charge, whether or not we hold personal information about you;
- Request that we provide you with a description of the personal information we hold about you, and to explain why and how it is being processed (please request Personal Information Request Form from Information Officer);
- Request that we consider your objections to the processing of your personal information (please request POPI Complaint Form from Information Officer);
- Lodge a complaint with the Information Regulator (please request POPI Complaint Form from Information Officer).

The forms for any of the above requests are available through access to our PAIA Manual in addition to contacting our Information Officer.

The Information Regulator

In the event that your personal information has not been processed in accordance with the POPI Act and the principles set out above, you have the right to lodge a complaint with the Information Regulator.
